During a lifetime each of us is bombarded by millions of images, the prime source being the news media, particularly newspapers and magazines. While these images impact our consciousness in ways we can only begin to comprehend, there are certain images that, over time, have become synonymous with the events they record.

Inspired by our complex, often emotional, relationship to images, photographer Roger Minick has culled forty news images from the six decades of his life—both iconic and banal—that have become indelibly fixed in his mind; then, as he did in his previous book *POEMSCAPES*, Minick has paired each image with a poem response. The resulting book, *IN THE NEWS*, is a personal expression of one person's evolving relationship to images, history and memory.
